Maths:

Measure

Compare, add/subtract: Length (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml). Comparing mixed units e.g. 1kg 200g

Statistics

Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. Solve problems using information presented in scaled bar charts, pictograms and tables

Geometry: property of shape

Recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn. Identify right angles, recognise that two right angles make a half turn, three make three quarters of a turn and four a complete turn; identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle. Identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines. Draw 2-D shapes and make 3-D shapes using modelling materials. Recognise 3-D shapes in different orientations and describe them.

History:

The Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. This includes: Viking raids and invasion, Anglo-Saxon laws and justice and Edward the Confessor and his death in 1066.

Forces and Magnets

Compare how things move on different surfaces, notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance

Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others
Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials. Describe magnets as having 2 poles, and predict whether 2 magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing

Light

Light and dark and how the absence of light affects this, how light is reflected from different surfaces, light from the sun and the dangers of this, the formation of shadows from a light source, and finding patterns in the size of and change of shadows.
