## Maths

### Number and Place Value

- Read, write, round, order and compare numbers to at least 1000000, counting forwards or backwards in steps of powers of 10.
- Interpret negative numbers in context, count forwards and backwards with positive and negative whole numbers including through zero.
- Read Roman numerals to 1000 (M) and recognise years written in Roman numerals

### Geometry- position and direction

- Reflection and translation in the first quadrant.

### Number- addition and subtraction

- Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits, including using formal written and mental methods
